GOOD EATS 2018 MEALS IN THE PARK OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. All meals will be held at City Park in the picnic area #2, unless announced.
- 2. Each team will be **reimbursed up to \$250** for the cost of the meal. Any cost overages will be the responsibility of the team members.
- 3. First name on the team list is the Team Captain. The Team Captain is responsible for submitting all receipts (up to \$250) to the club treasurer for reimbursement. All receipts must be submitted to treasurer no later than the Wednesday following your park meal. Miss the deadline, you miss getting reimbursed. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 4. All meals will be scored on the followings areas and point ranges of 0 to 25; 25 being highest scores:

 $\begin{array}{ll} \text{Quality} & 0-25 \\ \text{Quantity} & 0-25 \\ \text{Theme and menu} & 0-5 \end{array}$

Catered meals are allowed and will be reimbursed the actual cost up to \$250.

A catered meal is a meal where the **main course** has been prepared by a restaurant or other food establishment and brought to the park ready to serve. Example: pulled bbg pork prepared by Nordy's and brought to the park.

- 5. Each team member of the team chosen by ballot as the winning team will share a \$250 monetary prize.
- 6. Teams/team members may swap dates/teams. Inform your team captain of the change.
- 7. Meals will be held regardless of inclement weather unless the meeting is changed by Presidential Decree.
- 8. **KEEP IT SIMPLE!!** Some of the highest scoring meals last year were simple. The key is **quantity** and if the dish is supposed to be hot, **make sure it is hot** (The Classic Brian Johnson Green Bean Casserole Rule).
